The later concern about being welcome suggests belonging may feel conditional. I need to compare this with the request for a quiet week.
● Rules and care (1 passage)
“The rules said to water only our own plots. When my neighbor missed a week, I watered theirs too. I did not want their plants to suffer.” Volunteer A ● Rules and care · Coder: Practice coder
